Draft District Force Deployment Plan For By Election-2018 District :

General Principles Of Force Deployment

- 1. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) (eg.DAP) shall be deployed with all PCCPs.
- 2. All Polling Stations Locations (PSLs) in the Naxal areas shall be covered by at least One Section (2-8) of Central Armed Police Forces (CPF).
- 3. All Polling Stations Locations (PSLs) in Critical/General areas shall be covered by at least Half
- 4. The Polling Stations Locations (PSLs) having 3/4 Polling Stations shall be supplemented by the 1-4 State Police Force (SPF), besides the CPF already deployed.
- 5. The Polling Stations Locations (PSLs) having 5/6 Polling Stations shall be supplemented by the 2-8 State Police Force (SPF), besides the CPF already deployed.
- 6. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed with all Sector Officers, assuming One Sector for each 10 Polling Station.
- 7. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed with all Nakas (Check Posts)(apart from SST).
 - No. of Nakas (Check Posts) to be decided by the districts.
- 8. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed with all Static Surveillance Teams (Check Post) (SST). No. of SST to be same as per norms of the Election Commission => (3 per AC)
- 9. Half Section (1-4) CPF with One Police Officer shall be deputed with 67*3=201 Flying Squads in each of 67 sensitive Assembly Constituencies from expenditure point of view (3 FS per AC). In other constituencies, Half Section (1-4) SPF with One Police Officer shall be deputed with 3 Flying Squads in each of constituencies.
- 10. One Platoon CPF & Two Platoon SPF shall be deployed at all the Strong Rooms for EVM Guarding.
- 11. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed for the security of the Observers. (3 Observers per Assembly Constituency).
- 12. PSO from State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed for the security of the Candidates depending on the threat perception (1/3 of last AC Candidates).
- 13. One Police Officer for each company of CPF is to be deputed as Liaison Officer.
- 14. Half Section (1-4) State Police Force (SPF) shall be deployed as rushing parties with all the election related Supervisory Officers (ROs, Zonal Officers & Dy.SP).
- 15. Two Sections (4-16) CPF shall be deployed as QRTs at all the Naxal Police Stations. One Sections (2-8) CPF shall be deployed as QRTs at all the Non-Naxal Police Stations.
- 16. District Reserve shall be 8-32 SPF.
- 17. 4-16 SPF for District Control Room & 4-16 SPF as Sub-Divisional Control Room for all Sub-Divisions.
- 18. Area Domination-4-16 SPF for Each Constituency in Non-Naxal Areas and Existing CPF in Naxal Areas (where CPF not already there in any Naxal AC then one Platoon per AC – CPF).
- 19. ROP-As Per The Requirement Of The District.
- 20. De-Induction-Existing CPF in Naxal Areas.
- 21. 2 PSO & 2 Wireless Personnel Per Police Station for the Poll Day for Miscellaneous Duties.
- 22. One Police Personnel (SPF) for Each Polling Stations has to be deployed for queuing of voters.
